As you have, hopefully, heard from your children this year's Market Day is fast approaching. Students have been placed into groups based on the skills they possess, and each has taken on one of the following roles: Business Manager, Finance Manager, Health and Safety Manager, Advertising and Marketing Manager or Operations Manager.

This project requires students to buy and prepare food or buy resources for services that they provide to the school on Friday week 9 (June 28, 2019). Each group has its own stall and budget that they have set up using grocery store websites as a reference. Each group has been limited to \$15 per person. While we like to give students the authenticity and autonomy of organising their own group, we have suggested that their money be pooled so that any expenses are combined.

We have worked closely with the students to create budget friendly items and have suggested they can buy in bulk, shop at the markets on a Sunday afternoon (reduced prices) and split the costs between group members to keep costs to a minimum.

The money raised will go towards funding the Year 6 graduation and the traditional gift for the school.
