

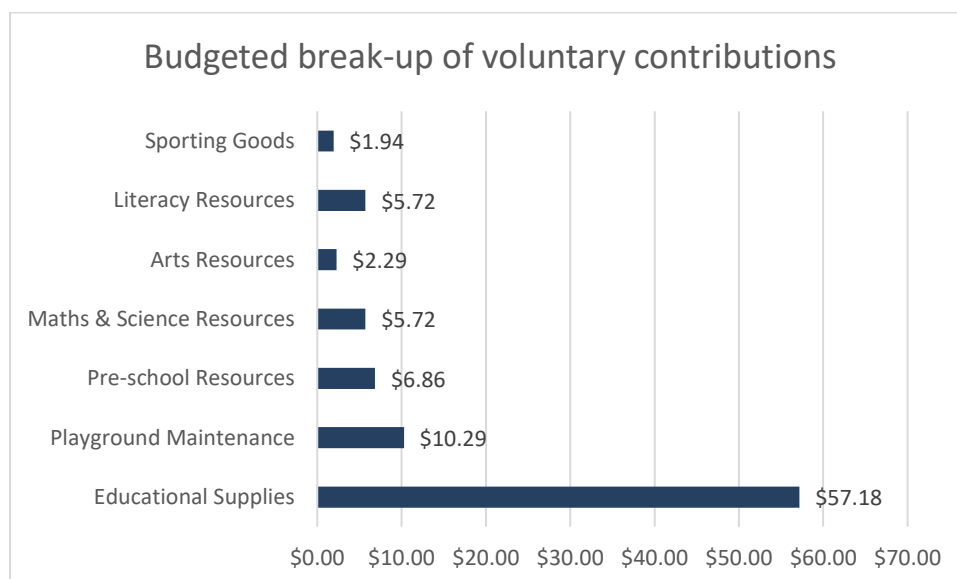
## Latham Primary School 2019 Voluntary Contributions

Dear Parents & Carers,

Voluntary contributions are funds provided by the parent/carer community to the school. These funds are used to support the Latham learning environment for all students from Preschool to Year 6.
