

School Concert Update

Dear families,

Concert day is almost here! We are busy finalising our performance numbers and gathering bits and pieces to put on a spectacular show for you all.

The concert committee would like to take this opportunity to bring you some last minute reminders and important information about the procedures for the evening performance.

Costumes

Costumes are **DUE now** to your child's classroom teacher **in a named bag** (a plastic shopping bag or large snap lock bag is more than suitable). Please ensure you get these in ASAP if you haven't already.

Dress Rehearsal

Monday 2 September (Week 7) in the Latham Primary School Hall at 11:30am until approx. 1:30pm. This is an opportunity for students to watch their peers perform.

Evening Performance

Tuesday 3 September (Week 7), concert beginning at 6pm until approx. 8pm at Kingsford Smith School. The performance will take place in the hall/gymnasium and can be accessed through the Hardwick Crescent entrance.

The P&C will also be running a BBQ Sausage Sizzle from 4:30pm.

Entry to this performance will be a gold coin donation.

Drop off and Pick Up of Students for Evening Performance

All students are to be dropped off at Kingsford Smith School between **5:00-5:30pm**. Please follow the signage at the school to your child's designated backstage area for the night. To ensure students' safety they **MUST** be signed in by you with their classroom teacher. Students will remain in breakout classroom spaces for the duration of the concert with their classroom teachers before and after their performances. **At no time during the concert may you visit backstage or collect your child unless previously discussed with your child's teacher.** At the end of the concert please return to your child's drop off point to collect them. You **MUST** sign your child out before taking them home. We appreciate your cooperation with these procedures to ensure our students' safety across the evening.
